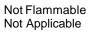

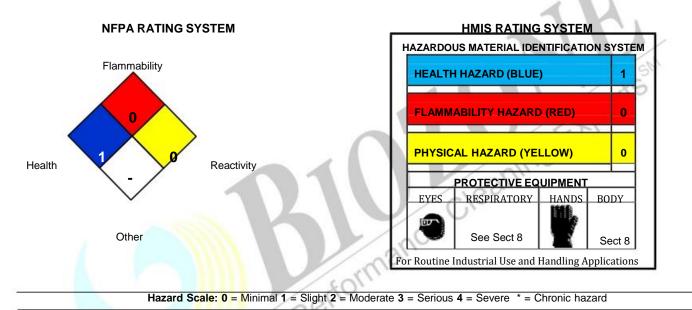

**Used to clean:** Healthcare instruments, laboratory ware, sampling apparatus, plate glass, animal cages, electronic components, pharmaceutical apparatus, cosmetics manufacturing equipment, metal castings forgings and stampings, industrial parts, tanks and reactors. Authorized by USDA for use in federally inspected meat and poultry plants. Passes inhibitory residue test for eater analysis. FDA certified.

**Used to remove:** Soil, grit, grime, slime, grease, tars, resins, fats, oils, blood, tissue, inorganic residues, particulates, solvents, chemical and solvents.
